### **School Uniform Policy**

The school uniform colour is Navy Blue

- Navy blue jumper or cardigan with school logo
- White Polo Shirt with school logo

#### **Boys:**

Plain navy trousers (not combat style) or navy school shorts. Plain black, navy or grey socks (no logo or cartoon characters please).

#### **Girls:**

Plain navy school trousers (not combat Style)/skirt/shorts/pinafore dress or optional light blue and white check summer dress/culottes. Plain black or navy socks (no logo, cartoon characters, or knee high patterned/striped socks please) White socks would be permitted during the nice weather when worn with summer dresses.. Plain navy or black tights.

#### **Footwear:**

Black sensible shoes. Not trainers, or fashion shoes. No visible logos and no ankle boots. For Health and Safety Reasons we are unable to allow open toe sandals.

#### **PE Kit:**

House team colour active wear tshirt, navy blue shorts for indoor PE and Summer wear or navy blue track suit for outdoor PE and Winter wear. Black or white trainers/black plimsolls for outdoor PE and CLEAN Black or white trainers or Black plimsolls for indoor PE. Children should tie their hair up during PE lessons.

#### **Jewellery**

Children may wear only a pair of stud earrings and a watch: No hooped earrings, necklaces, rings or bracelets are allowed. However, children may wear a small crucifix, for religious purposes, but this must be worn underneath their shirt.

For Health and Safety reasons children may not participate in PE if wearing earrings. Please ensure that they can remove them themselves or do not wear them on day of PE or Swimming.

#### **Hair**

The school does not allow extremes of hair fashion i.e. no lines, cuts, patterns, shaved heads, or obvious dyeing of the hair. Please check with school first if you are unsure. Hair should look natural.

- Hair must be kept tidy in the interests of safety (long hair tied back).
- No marks/cuts allowed in eyebrows.

*Clothing should be clearly labelled with the child's name. Coats are a personal choice, but hoodies, sweatshirts and denim jackets are not considered to be coats.*

**In all matters concerning uniform, the Headteacher's decision is final.
