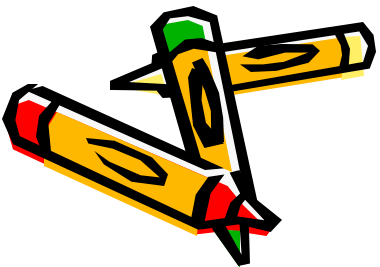

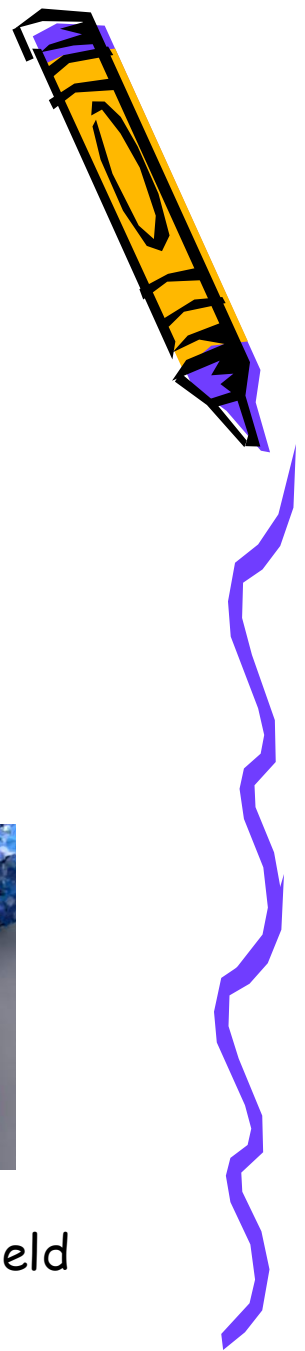

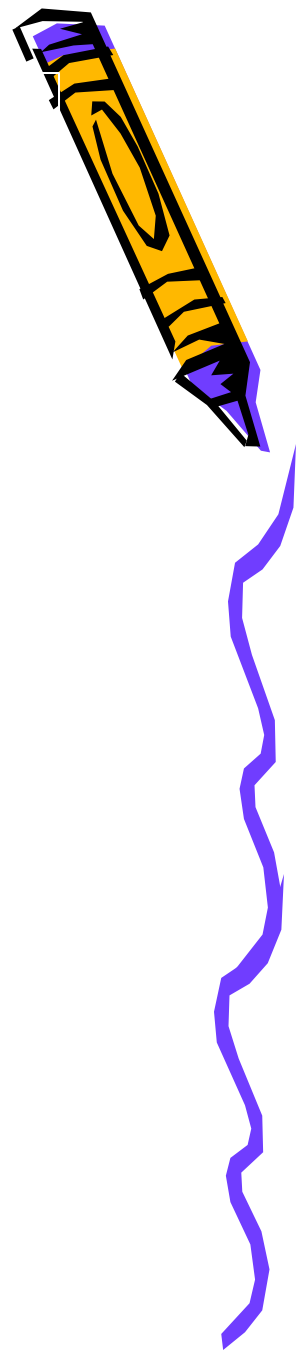

Role of Parents

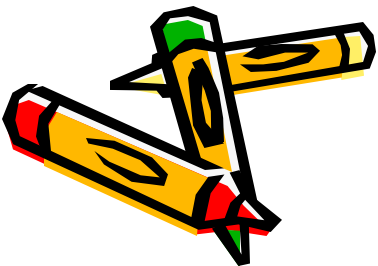
Your role is crucial to your child's success this year. Their best can be achieved through:

- Children are encouraged to independently hang up coats, wash hands and start their morning work.



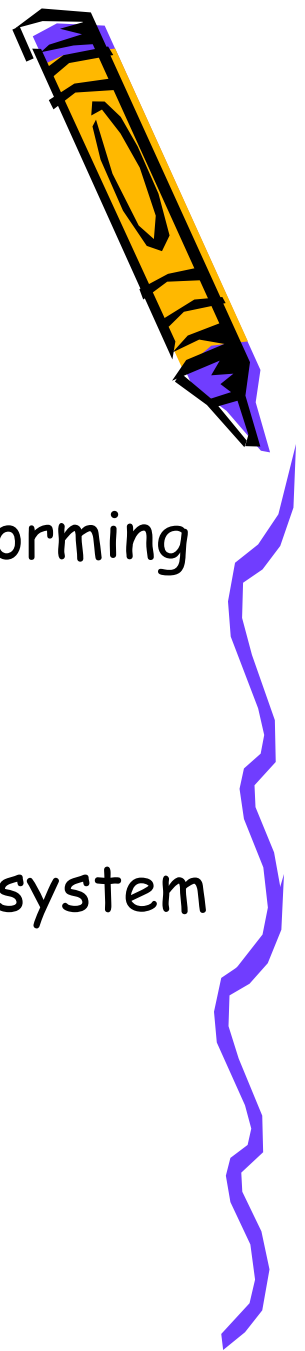
Letters

Home Reading Books



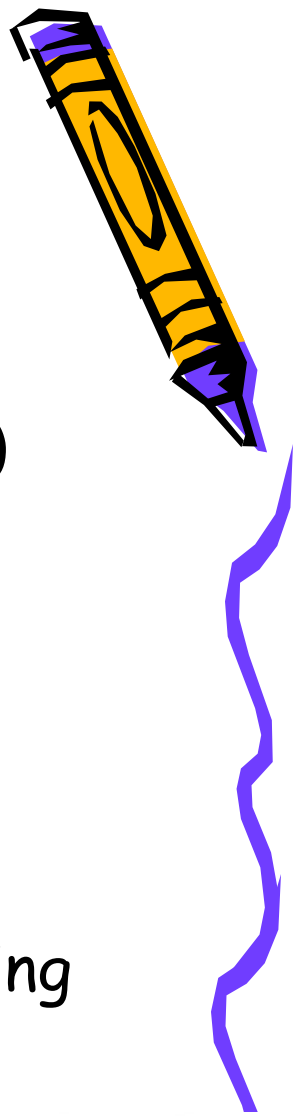
- Please hand reading records in on **Wednesday**. Please encourage your child to record books read in their Reading Record.

- 1 online book- this has been read every day during RWI sessions

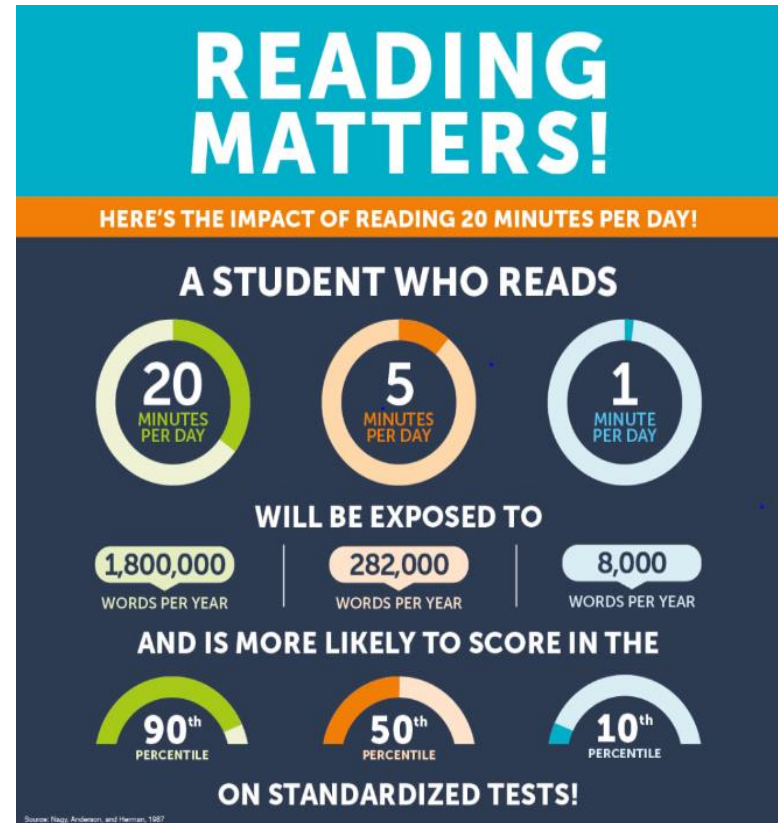
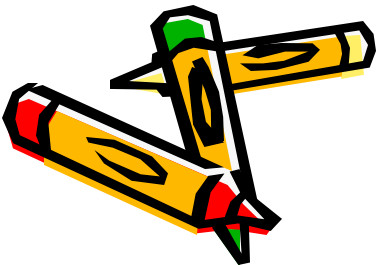


Reading for Pleasure

- Pleasure in reading in later life

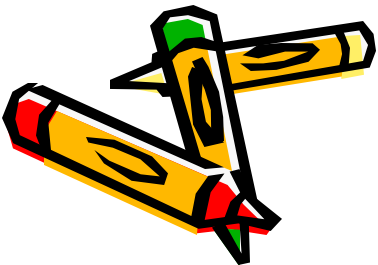




Homework

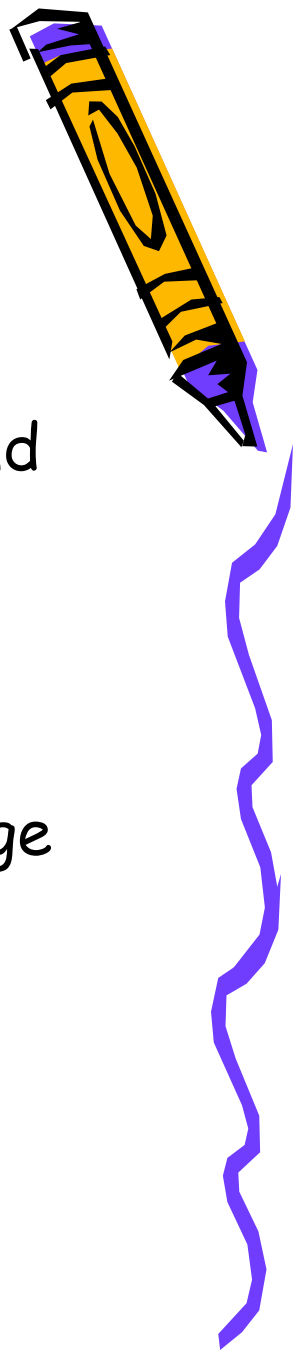


- Reading is on-going homework

- Spellings will be sent home on a **Thursday** and these will be checked on a **Monday**

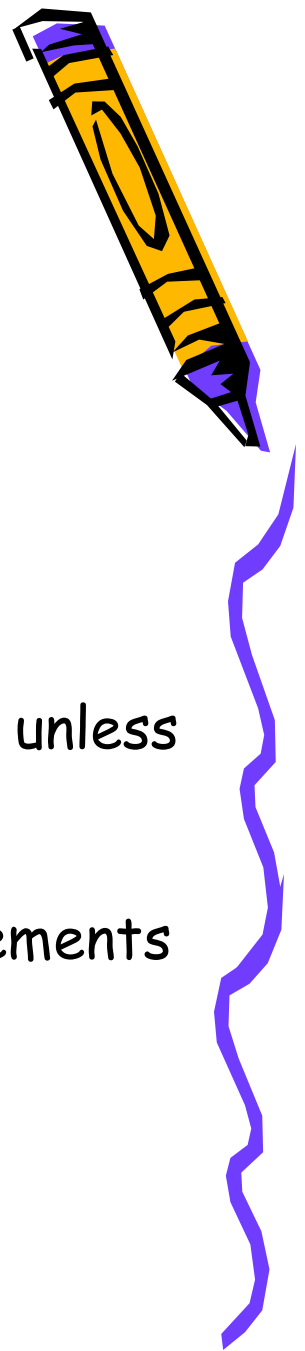


Allergies/snacks

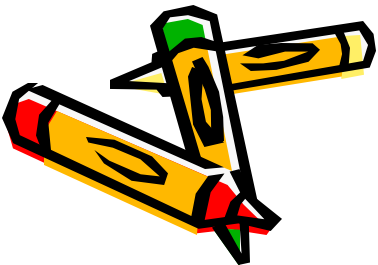
- Please be careful about the food you might send into school. No nuts (including Nutella)

- Please inform us of change of contact details/arrangements



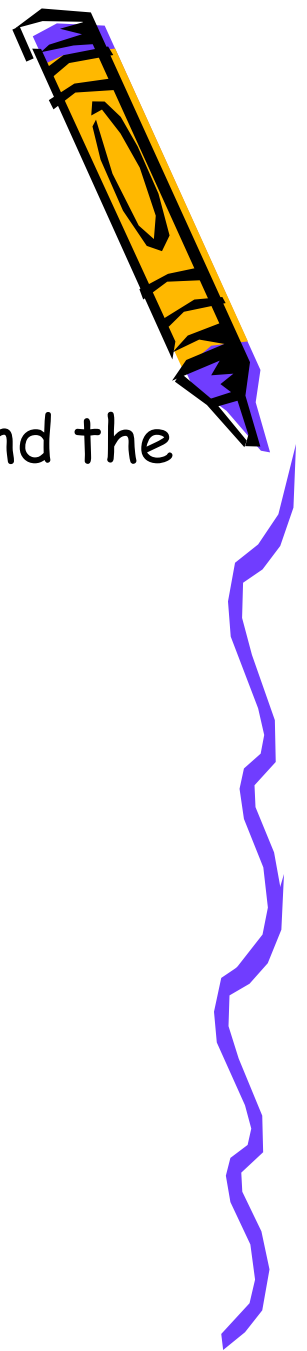
Behaviour System / Rewards

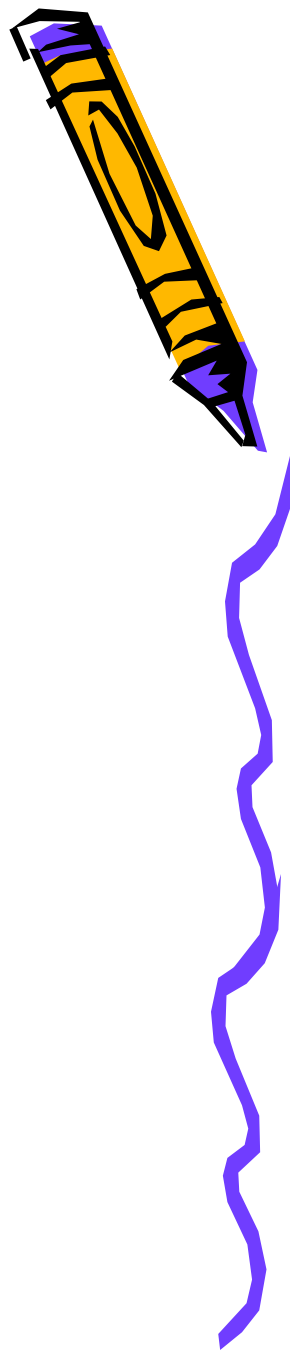
