




#### Role of Parents

- Please keep an eye on the school newsletter and our class page for regular updates.





## Home Reading


- Regular reading (everyday if possible)

- 1 online book- this has been read every day during RWI sessions






#### Reading for Pleasure

## <u>Homework</u>


- Reading is on-going homework

- Spellings will be sent home on a Thursday and these will be checked on a Monday






# Allergies/snacks

- Please inform us of change of contact details/arrangements




# Behaviour System / Rewards


