## Why Reading 20 Minutes a Night is so Critical

## Multiplication Check

- The multiplication tables check is statutory for primary schools. This will take place in June.
- The MTC is an online test where the pupils are asked 25 questions on times tables 2 to 12.
- For every question they have 6 seconds to answer and in between the questions there is a 3 second rest.
- Questions about the $6,7,8,9$, and 12
$3 \times 12=$
 times table come up more often.
- The questions are generated randomly.
