What is Phonics?

- In Reception & KS1 children have phonics lessons 5 times a week following the Read Write Inc scheme.
- Children are taught to read by breaking down words into separate sounds (called 'phonemes'). E.g c-a-t.
- •They are taught how to **blend** (join) these sounds together to read the whole word e.g. c-o-m-i-c

"T-A-BL

There are 44 different sounds.

What happens during the Check?

- The test contains 40 words.
- Each child will sit one-to-one and read each word aloud to a teacher.
- The test will take approximately <u>10 minutes</u> per child, although all children are different and will complete the check at their own pace.
- The list of words the children read is a combination of <u>20</u> real words and <u>20 pseudo words</u> (nonsense words).



Pseudo Words (Nonsense Words/Alien words)

- The pseudo words will be shown to your child with a picture of an alien.
- This provides the children with a context for the pseudo word which is independent from any existing vocabulary they may have.
- Pseudo words are included because they will be new to all pupils; they do not favour children with a good vocabulary knowledge or visual memorals.



And the results..?

· Children will be scored against a national standard.

(32/40 in previous years)


- Data will be submitted first and schools will be informed of the pass mark at a later date.
- Parents will be informed of results with the end of year reports.
- If your child's score falls below the national standar they will re-take the Phonic Screening Check in Year 2

How are we preparing at school?

- Extra practise sessions in the afternoons.
- •1:1 green card word reading and alien word reading.
- ·Lexia in school in the ICT suite.
- •Practice Phonics Screening Checks so we know what sounds need more practice.
- Reading fiction and non fiction books
- Phonics games.

How can you help?

Phonics packs:

•REMEMBER: Phonics is not the only way you become a good reader.

Continue to read with your child each night and encourage them to:

- Sound out, re-read to check it makes sense, and use pictures for clues.
- Ask questions about the book;
